Taylor (Appellant) <i>v</i> General Legal Council (Exparte Patrick Brooks) (Respondent) (Jamaica) JCPC 2014/0034	Lord Mance Lord Sumption Lord Carnwath	Refused 8 October 2014	Permission to appeal should be refused because the application does not raise an arguable point of law or any prospect of success on the facts.
